### ARTS & CRAFTS SHOW ENTRY

Exhibitors are permitted by invitation only. **(All first time exhibitors must submit pictures of their work)**. All exhibitors must be on file with the Lena Arts & Crafts Committee. The fee is **\$25.00** for one 12' by 12' space. Electricity is limited. Please bring your own extension cords. Please make checks payable to Lena Day. **Deadline for application is June 30, 2011.**

### Procedures

The Lena Arts & Crafts Committee reserves the right to juror all exhibits during show time. Constructive criticism and comments are **ALWAYS WELCOME!** However, rudeness to any Committee member will not be tolerated.

### Acceptance of Exhibitors

All exhibitors of the Lena Show must maintain exhibits entered on application. Any additional art or craft must be approved by the Committee. The Committee reserves the right to have questionable items removed from display.

### Booth Set Up

Exhibitors must make their own provisions for shade and for rain. Generators are allowed. We encourage our exhibitors to display their crafts in an attractive manner.

### Acceptance

If you are accepted by the Committee, you will be notified as soon as possible by mail. Please enclose a self addressed stamped envelope with your application.

- 1) Any application not completed in its entirety may be returned. The committee reserves the right to reject any exhibitor.
- 2) Exhibit space will be on a first come first serve basis. Do NOT ask to be moved.
- 3) The fee for an approximate 12' by 12' exhibit space is \$25.00. Electricity is \$10.00 extra. Deadline for application is **June 30, 2011.**
- 4) The Lena Fourth of July Committee is not responsible for theft or accidents.
- 5) NO food or drink items may be sold except for homemade jellies, jams, honey, etc.
- 6) NO rummage or garage type items will be allowed.
- 7) NO raffles will be allowed and no refunds.
- 8) The Lena Arts & Crafts Committee reserves the right to juror all exhibits during the show time. Constructive criticism and comments are **ALWAYS WELCOME!**
- 9) No fireworks will be allowed to be sold.
- 10) Vendors agree, by signing this agreement to release the City of Lena and the Leake County Chamber of Commerce, from any claims for loses, injuries, or damages that may be suffered by the vendor or property while participating in the event. Booth space will be free of litter and tents taken down before leaving.
